EWING FALL SPIN GUIDANCE - SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 30, 2023

1. Sign in from 8:00 am at Campus Town right side parking lot or show liability signed, pay or show receipt, pickup cue sheets, instructions and T-shirt.
2. Ensure your bike and gear are safe and legal [helmets required, horn, brakes, tires] [GMTMA may have helmets]
3. Ask advice of Knapp's Cyclery rep if desired.
4. Assemble by 8:30 am in a single file between police and ride leaders and move out.
5. Some roads lack shoulders so buddy up there, keep single file in right lane!!
6. We cross several busy intersections so let police & leaders guide you!
7. Always signal intentions to stop, turn or pass and then do so safely.
8. Point out road hazards and approaching vehicles to riders behind you.
